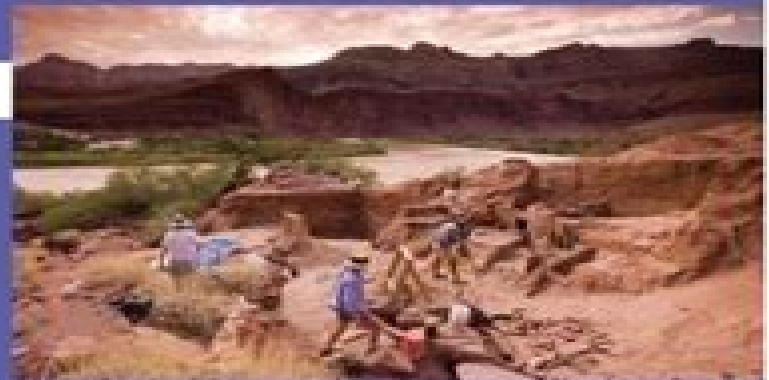

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Prehistory Colin Renfrew, 2008-08-19 In *Prehistory* the award winning archaeologist and renowned scholar Colin Renfrew covers human existence before the advent of written records which is to say the overwhelming majority of our time here on earth But Renfrew also opens up to discussion and even debate the term prehistory itself giving an incisive concise and lively survey of the past and how scholars and scientists labor to bring it to light Renfrew begins by looking at prehistory as a discipline particularly how developments of the past century and a half advances in archaeology and geology Darwin's ideas of evolution discoveries of artifacts and fossil evidence of our human ancestors and even more enlightened museum and collection curatorship have fueled continuous growth in our knowledge of prehistory He details how breakthroughs such as radiocarbon dating and DNA analysis have helped us to define humankind's past how things have changed much more clearly than was possible just a half century ago Answers for why things have changed however continue to elude us so Renfrew discusses some of the issues and challenges past and present that confront the study of prehistory and its investigators In the book's second part Renfrew shifts the narrative focus offering a summary of human prehistory from early hominids to the rise of literate civilization that is refreshingly free from conventional wisdom and grand unified theories The author's own case studies encompass a vast geographical and chronological range the Orkney Islands the Balkans the Indus Valley Peru Ireland and China and help to explain the formation and development of agriculture and centralized societies He concludes with a fascinating chapter on early writing systems From *Prehistory to History* In this invaluable brief account of human development prior to the last four millennia Colin Renfrew delivers a meticulously researched and passionately argued chronicle about our life on earth and our ongoing quest to understand it *Archaeology* Colin Renfrew, Paul G. Figuring It Out Colin Renfrew, 2003-03-25 Where do we come from What are we Where are we going These questions were posed by Paul Gauguin in a famous canvas painted in Tahiti that heralded the beginning of the modernist era But they are also the questions asked by modern prehistorians in their quest to reconstruct the human story In *Figuring It Out* Colin Renfrew investigates the profound convergence between the two disciplines drawing illuminating parallels between the way the modern artist seeks to understand the world by acting upon it and the way the archaeologist seeks to understand the world through the material traces of such actions What does the sapient paradox the fact that 30 000 years passed before anatomically modern humans began to change their world have to tell us about the unfolding of the history of our species Why do we now find Cycladic sculpture beautiful when merely a century ago such work would not have been thought suitable for display in an art museum And how is it that in the light of Marcel Duchamp's revolutionary gallery based gestures the prehistoric footsteps at Laetoli have been admitted as art too albeit of an involuntary kind Professor Renfrew uses these questions as a springboard for his examination of the history of the human condition a subject that can only be properly

Hoffeecker,2011-05-31 In Landscape of the Mind John F Hoffeecker explores the origin and growth of the human mind drawing on archaeology history and the fossil record He suggests that as an indirect result of bipedal locomotion early humans developed a feedback relationship among their hands brains and tools that evolved into the capacity to externalize thoughts in the form of shaped stone objects When anatomically modern humans evolved a parallel capacity to externalize thoughts as symbolic language individual brains within social groups became integrated into a neocortical Internet or super brain giving birth to the mind Noting that archaeological traces of symbolism coincide with evidence of the ability to generate novel technology Hoffeecker contends that human creativity as well as higher order consciousness is a product of the superbrain He equates the subsequent growth of the mind with human history which began in Africa more than 50 000 years ago As anatomically modern humans spread across the globe adapting to a variety of climates and habitats they redesigned themselves technologically and created alternative realities through tools language and art Hoffeecker connects the rise of civilization to a hierarchical reorganization of the super brain triggered by explosive population growth Subsequent human history reflects to varying degrees the suppression of the mind's creative powers by the rigid hierarchies of nationstates and empires constraining the further accumulation of knowledge The modern world emerged after 1200 from the fragments of the Roman Empire whose collapse had eliminated a central authority that could thwart innovation Hoffeecker concludes with speculation about the possibility of artificial intelligence and the consequences of a mind liberated from its organic antecedents to exist in an independent nonbiological form **Material Engagements** Neil Brodie,2004 The subject matter of archaeology is the engagement of human beings now and in the past with both the natural world and the material world they have created All aspects of human activity are potentially relevant to archaeological research and conversely the ways in which others especially artists and anthropologists have investigated the world are of interest to archaeologists Archaeological artefacts and sites are also used by groups and nations to establish identity and for financial gain both through tourism and trade in antiquities Colin Renfrew has actively engaged with art with politics and with the antiquities trade and has presented his ideas to broad audiences through accessible books and television programmes as well as championing the cause of archaeology in many public roles The papers in this volume which have been written by colleagues and former students on the occasion of his retirement relate to all of these subject areas and together give some idea of the complexity of the issues raised by critical engagements with the material world both past and present **BELIEF IN THE PAST** David S Whitley,Kelley Hays-Gilpin,2008-07-15 Human actions are often deeply intertwined with religion and can be understood in a strictly religious context Yet many volumes and articles pertaining to discussions of religion in the archaeological past have focused primarily on the sociopolitical implications of such remains The authors in this volume
