

*Discursos e Identidades en la Ficción Romántica / Discourses and Identities in Romance Fiction* María Isabel González-Cruz, 2022-03-01 Despreciado por la crítica por su condición de literatura popular y femenina el género romántico no solo continúa imbatible en el mercado editorial con su elevado índice de ventas sino que en las últimas décadas está siendo objeto de interesantes estudios académicos. *Discursos e Identidades en la Ficción Romántica* se suma a esta corriente al abordar el análisis interdisciplinar de un corpus de novelas publicadas en lengua inglesa entre 1955 y 2004.
