Explain the role of smoking in the pathogenesis of COPD.

Cigarette smoke comprises of extremely high concentration of oxidants. These oxidant substances are very reactive and cause inflammation in the lung and its airway. Smoking triggers and inflammatory process in the peripheral airways, central airways, and lung parenchyma. Bronchial biopsies of smokers from central airways, smokers have chronic inflammatory changes, with amplified numbers of specific inflammatory cell types in different parts of the lung. The role of smoking cessation on the airway inflammation development in COPD is not clearly defined. The inflammatory and structural changes in the airways rise with disease severity and continue despite smoking cessation.

In relation to the underlying pathological processes explain the origin of the vesicular sounds that can be heard during auscultation.

Auscultation of the lung is a central part of the respiratory examination and is supportive in diagnosing various respiratory disorders. Chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases (COPD) patients develop widespread airway obstruction; therefore, wheezes are heard at all the area of the chest. Localized airway blockade by a foreign body, mucous plug, or tumorresults in focal wheezing. Crackles are louder, low-pitched, and less in number per breath, whereas, fine crackles are softer, higher-pitched, and more in number per breath. Crackles are observed in pulmonary disorders, for example COPD, pneumonia, pulmonaryedema, interstitial lung disease, and heart failure. They appear at the start of inspiration and end before mid-inspiration, for example, COPD. Crackles in COPD patients are gravity-independent, scanty, audible at the mouth and strongly linked with severe airway obstruction.
