- a new section on the history of the planet before 4 billion years ago (the Hadean),
- the role of TTGs in production of continental crust,
- the sporadicity of crustal and mantle events through time,
- a new section on Earth's forming history,
- a new section on Earth's magnetic field and possible extraterrestrial life,
- a significant enlargement of the supercontinent chapter,
- new developments in the great mass extinction at the end of the Permian,
- a new discussion of when and how plate tectonics began, and
- a new discussion of exoplanets in space and time,
- a significantly expanded discussion of extraterrestrial planets.
