points to three fundamental characteristics of decisions First it is assumed that a choice of possible decisions or more precisely of possible alternatives is available If only one choice is possible there is no decision problem and the question of rationality does not arise Usually of course there will be a choice even if the alternative is to decide not to decide a choice that of course often has profound consequences
