school leaders with opportunities to enact and examine their leadership approaches decisions and policies without consequence Building on medical education's use of standardized patients this book introduces standardized individuals and clinical simulations into the field of school leader preparation In live one to one interactions school leaders engage in variety of professional situations with standardized students parents teachers and community members Each carefully scripted standardized individual presents a problem of practice while unscripted school leader participants are free to enact their own professional knowledge dispositions and decision making approaches as they engage within a simulation When confronted by an angry father in simulation leaders practice their explanations and policies surrounding challenged curriculum When presented with an inebriated student in simulation leaders enact decision steps associated with student discipline and
