Clinical psychology notes

Clinical psychology – involves using clinical judgement to apply scientific knowledge from the discipline of clinical psychology in clinical practice with clients & patients.

What is a clinical psychologist:

- A research-oriented scientist-practitioner bound by quantitivism & rules needs to be effective.
- A practice-oriented practitioner scholar more of a therapist they're engaging/learning by doing = it's vocational.
- 3) A reflective practitioner more of a counsellor type

What should a clinical psychologist do? – They're judged on what research they know, NOT what they do & how they apply it in a scientific manner.

- Assessments some questions / case notes / medical history / practitioner experience / opinions (following a consistent model of practice & formulating an opinion based on the assessment).
- 2) Diagnosis
- 3) Prescribe drugs e.g. depression anti-depressants.
- 4) Formulation process of decision making you create some kind of reasoning for why the person has that problem – from that reason, intervention = created
- Interventions / therapy.

 Clinical judgement – developed through supervised clinical practice while undertaking professional training & accumulated clinical practice.

Clinical practice – assessment, treatment & prevention of psychological problems.

 Scientific knowledge – developed through initial academic training, continual professional development (CPD) & training – read about research.
