The use of correct acceptable and appropriate sound lighting and art direction in film production is essential to present the film realistically to the audience on the screen In film subtext is the underlying meaning that enriches the content of scenes dialogues or characters but never directly manifests itself in visual cues dialogue or story narration. However the subtext can be fully inferred through the scenes dialogues and actions expressions or context of the characters in the film
