important to work giving a greater diffusion to these issues since considering psychosocial interventions in the context in which they occur goes beyond an epistemological or methodological discussion. Rather these considerations seriously affect the ability of practitioners to really reach the people who need their interventions: listening to their needs and respecting their preferences. For the editors of this book then the contextualization of interventions means considering the people who receive them as full citizens immersed in complex societies where factors such as social justice and health or well being do not float apart in space but affect each other dialectically.
