Based on the author's extensive primary source research and interviews with key protagonists *Saviours of the Nation* examines both the causes and the consequences of the opposition's transformation into a nationalist force. Highlighting the role of historical context it argues that three main factors contributed to the intellectuals' elaboration of a radical nationalist ideology: abandonment of cultural Yugoslavism in conjunction with the post Tito crisis of the state; difficulties in solving the thorny Kosovo question and relationships between the dissidents and their Slovenian counterparts.
