Abb. 33, S. 43) nur angedeutete Vordergrund ist im Aquarell vermutlich nach Skizzen aus anderem Naturzusammenhang ausgeführt. Die Entstehungszeit ist umstritten. Man hat einerseits eine stilistische Verwandtschaft mit dem Aquarell "Kreidefelsen auf Rügen" gesehen und ist zu einer Datierung um 1824/26 gekommen. Für andere deutet die "lockere Malweise, besonders charakteristisch im Gras des Vordergrundes, ebenso wie der gedankliche Gehalt auf eine Entstehung um 1837/ 40."
