 Continuous data: $\bar{x} = \frac{\sum f_i x_i}{\sum f_i}$ value
 Continuous data with frequency (f_i) = joint value
 To estimate median from grouped data:

- Find cumulative frequency of first column until you get to joint value and find the class interval with the median
- Find how many more values you require from class to get the median
- Divide that number by the frequency of that class
- Multiply that answer by the class width
- Add your answer to the lower bound of the class interval
