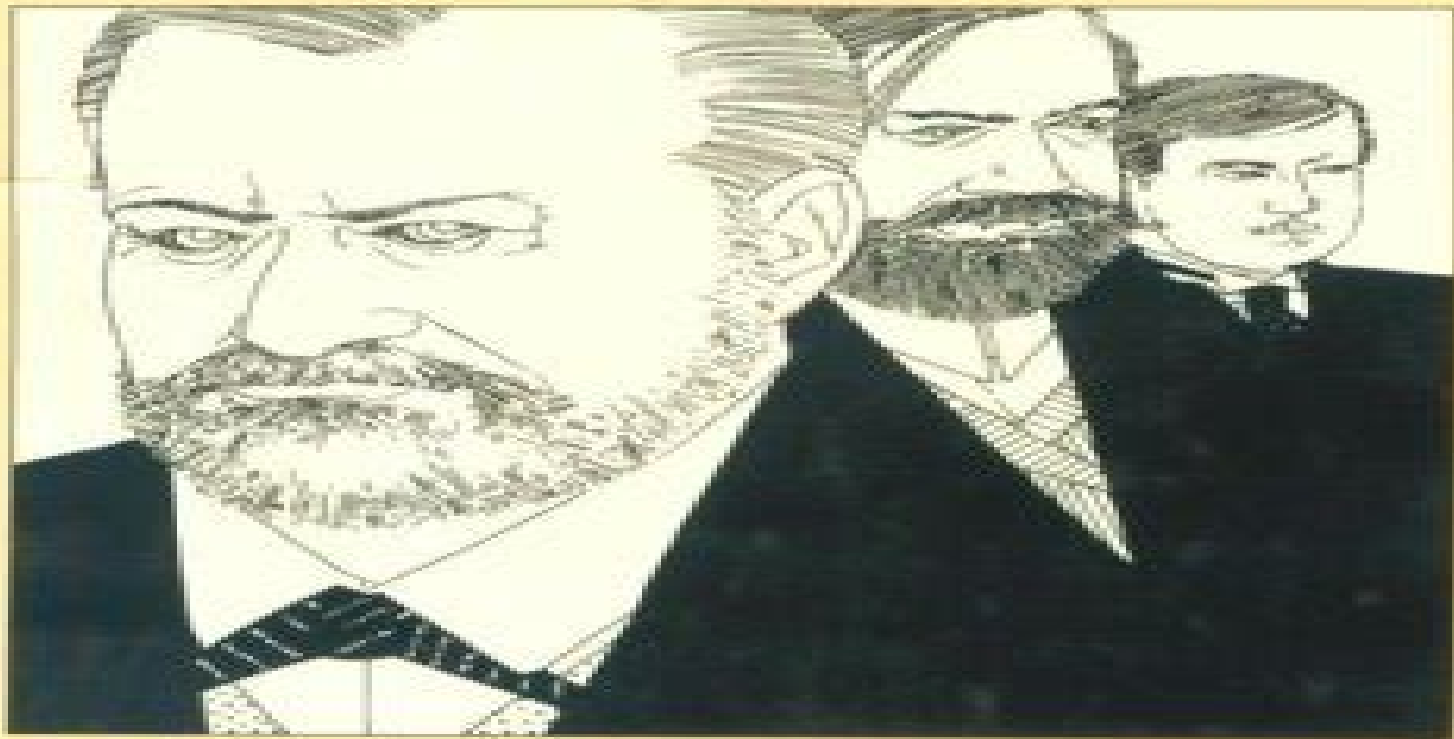

Freud Peter M. Newton, 1994-12-02 Using revelations gained from recently published correspondence this provocative biography sheds new light on current debates about Sigmund Freud's theories. The book demonstrates how giving up the seduction theory that all neurosis results from the molestation of small children by their fathers swept Freud into a mid life crisis out of which he eventually fought his way through to the discovery of psychoanalysis. Examining the newly released highly personal letters between Freud and his boyhood friend Eduard Silberstein along with the letters of his 20s to his fiancée Martha Bernays and those to the confidant during his mid life transition Wilhelm Fliess, this volume provides valuable insight into Freud's development both as a man and as a thinker. Peter M. Newton captures the drama of Freud's first love and heartbreak, the defiant and complicated ambitions of Freud's later adolescence, and the historic creative accomplishment and personal reward of his mid life transition. Applying a theory of lives to this great complex story, Newton charts the evolution of Freud's thought through a continuing sequence of developmental periods and tasks. He shows that contrary to accepted opinion, Freud dreamed of becoming not just a cloistered scientist but a revolutionary healer as well. The author demonstrates that the two aspects of Freud's dream and of his identity, that of quiet scholar and revolutionary healer, warred for possession of Freud's soul throughout his entire life. Exploring the years of Freud's transition to middle age, the book also lays to rest Jeffrey Masson's widely trumpeted accusation that Freud gave up his seduction theory out of political expediency. From a close study of Freud's letters to Wilhelm Fliess, Newton shows that it was not a desire to placate the medical establishment but the accumulating weight of Freud's own clinical experience that dashed the seduction theory. He then examines in depth the mid life crisis Freud suffered as a result of giving up the seduction theory. Without the theory, Freud felt he had no way to realize either the scientific or the clinical aspect of his dream. Newton's developmental approach to adulthood centers his account on questions such as: How at the age of 41, if the dream to which Freud had devoted the first 20 years of his adult life was shattered, could he guide the next 20? How could he salvage from the wreckage of his youth the elements of a life worth living as a middle aged man? And if he was neither a first rate scientist nor an expert doctor, who was he? A breakthrough study of developmental crisis and triumph, this volume will be welcomed by anyone who wishes to better understand one of the world's most important and influential thinkers. **Freud From Youthful Dream to Mid Life Crisis** also serves as a valuable text for undergraduate and graduate courses in human development, adult development, psychopathology, and personality, as well as courses on Freud and on developments in psychoanalytic institutes.

analytic process provide an illuminating close up of Sigmund Freud at work Through the words of his own patients the reader is introduced to an organized persistent personally engaged and expressive clinician who relied on free association rather than transference and resistance analysis to move the treatment The authors examine these cases along with those of the well known Rat Man and Wolf Man to see how Freud organized the treatment dyad in terms of its primary task and the division of labor between himself and his patient They then compare their findings with Freud s papers on technique and with the dominant ideals of mainstream contemporary psychoanalysis Contrary to the capricious Freud of in house clinical lore the starched Freud of Strachey s Standard Edition and the blank screen of traditional orthodoxy Lohser and Newton demonstrate that Freud was explicit about defining the primary task making the unconscious conscious directly instituted free association as the means to accomplish the task and actively monitored his patient s compliance with it The authors also demonstrate the implications of Freud s actual approach for the nature of the analytic relationship Since Freud relied on free association rather than transference and resistance analysis he could be more spontaneous and personal In contrast by making transference analysis the engine of the treatment the contemporary clinician ends up subordinating the entirety of his or her behavior to protecting the transference neutrality unilaterality and extreme abstinence are inevitable consequences This may be a good way to do psychoanalysis but it turns out not to be Freudian Opening an important debate about the nature of Freudian practice as Sigmund Freud himself practiced it Lohser and Newton contend that the cases presented in this volume clearly demonstrate that the dominant image of the Freudian analyst is not in fact classical but rather a neo orthodox stereotype

Freud's Theory and Its Use in Literary and Cultural Studies Henk de Berg, 2004 Rarely has a single figure had as much influence on Western thought as Sigmund Freud His ideas permeate our culture to such a degree that an understanding of them is indispensable Yet many otherwise well informed students in the humanities labor under misconceptions or lack of knowledge about Freudian theory There are countless introductions to Freudian psychoanalysis but surprisingly none that combine a genuinely accessible account of Freud's ideas with an introduction to their use in literary and cultural studies as this book does It is written specifically for use by advanced undergraduate and graduate students in courses dealing with literary and cultural criticism yet will also be of interest to the general reader The book consists of two parts Part one explains Freud's key ideas focusing on the role his theories of repression conscious and unconscious mental processes sexuality dreams free associations Freudian slips resistance and transference play in psychoanalysis and on the relationship between ego superego and id Here de Berg refutes many popular misconceptions using examples throughout The assumption underlying this account is that Freud offers not simply a model of the mind but an analysis of the relation between the individual and society Part two discusses the implications of Freudian psychoanalysis for the study of literature and culture Among the topics analyzed are Hamlet Heinrich Heine's *Lore Ley* Freud's Totem and Taboo and its influence on literature the German student movement of the late 1960s and the case of the Belgian pedophile Marc Dutroux and the public reactions to it Existing books focus either on Freudian psychoanalysis in general or on psychoanalytic literary or cultural criticism those in the latter category tend to be abstract and theoretical in nature None of them are suitable for readers who are interested in psychoanalysis as a tool for literary and cultural criticism but have no firm knowledge of Freud's ideas Freu
