The blend of first-hand experiences and reflections of the urban practitioners featured reframes design practice beyond the design of physical objects and public amenities to the design of social protocols, processes, and infrastructures for radically reframing practices of socio-spatial inclusion on the ground. Through illustrated examples, this book features the work of Stalker and Stealth who employ design to negotiate new social contracts, Teddy Cruz's design of urban political and economic processes, models of urban pedagogy by the Center for Urban Pedagogy, Cohabitation Strategies' work on designing urban social cooperatives, and others. Concurrent Urbanities presents a compendium of the emerging models of design-driven urban practice that offers important new insights to professional urban practitioners as well as to students of urbanism, architecture, urban design, and urban and spatial planning.
