the court documents of colonial Massachusetts may appear unexceptional in fact they reflect a rapidly changing world Native American marital relations and domestic lives were anothema to English Christians elite men frequently took more than one wife while ordinary people could dissolve their marriages and take new partners with relative ease Native marriage did not necessarily involve cohabitation the formation of a new household or mutual dependence for subsistence Couples who wished to separate did so without social opprobrium and when adultery occurred the blame centered not on the fallen woman but on the interloping man Over time such practices changed but the emergence of new types of Indian marriage enabled the legal social and cultural survival of New England's native peoples.
