I'm interested in a poetics of memory which literalizes a post-retrieval idea of memory¹. Writing, in this undertaking, is not an instrument of the retrieval of *stored* information. Rather, it is characterized as a *technology* of memory, and memory as *tekhne*, writing. I'm interested thus in rethinking the relationality, the mutual articulation of the two terms memory and writing.

According to Frow's 'logic of textuality', the text is a closed system and the past is a function of that system. It is not conceived of as an event outside the text. Rather, its meaning is determined retroactively and repetitively in the process of reading. If repetition is constitutive of memory, then a writing which investigates the poetics of
