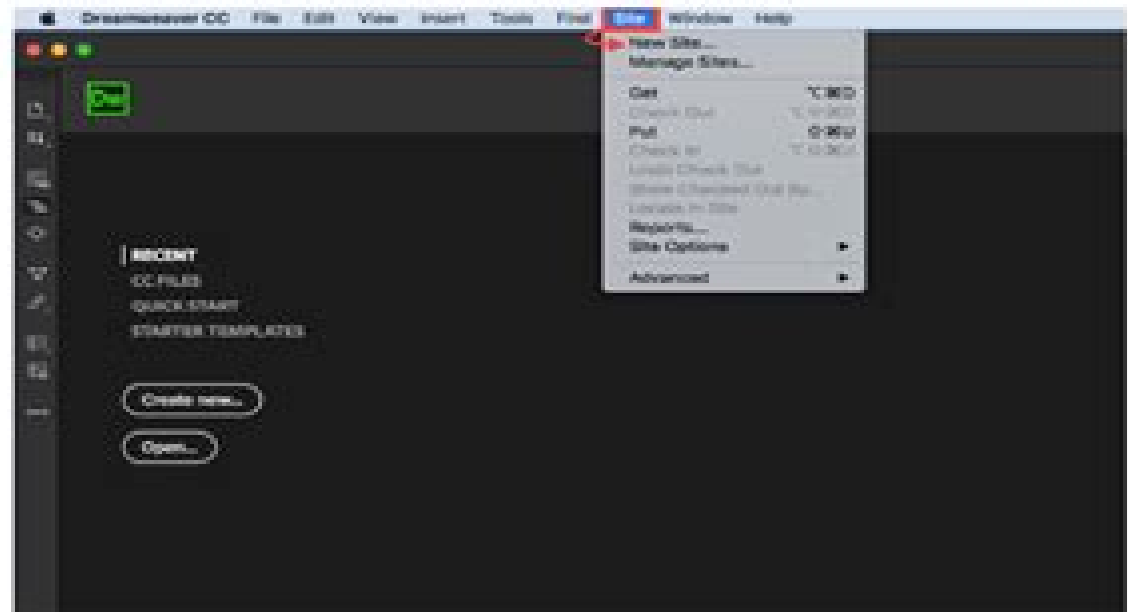
Step 1: Making a local folder
