Commentaries on Election and Predestination John Calvin, 2015-11-27 John Calvin 10 July 1509 27 May 1564 was one of the most influential Christians of the last millennium An influential French theologian and pastor during the Protestant Reformation Calvin was a principal figure in the development of the system of Christian theology later named after him Originally trained as a humanist lawyer he broke from the Roman Catholic Church around 1530 and after religious tensions provoked a violent uprising against Protestants in France Calvin fled to Basel Switzerland where he published the first edition of his seminal work *Institutes of the Christian Religion* in 1536 Calvin was a tireless polemic and apologetic writer who generated much controversy He also exchanged cordial and supportive letters with many reformers including Philipp Melancthon and Heinrich Bullinger In addition to the *Institutes* he wrote commentaries on most books of the Bible as well as theological treatises and confessional documents He regularly preached sermons throughout the week in Geneva Calvin was influenced by the Augustinian tradition which led him to expound the doctrine of predestination and the absolute sovereignty of God in salvation of the human soul from death and eternal damnation Calvin's writing and preachings provided the seeds for the branch of theology that bears his name The Reformed and Presbyterian churches which look to Calvin as a chief expositor of their beliefs have spread throughout the world

Commentaries which I extol in loftier terms than Helmich himself a Dutch divine 1551 1608 for I affirm that he excels beyond comparison in the interpretation of Scripture and that his commentaries ought to be more highly valued than all that is handed down to us by the library of the fathers so that I acknowledge him to have possessed above most others or rather above all other men what may be called an eminent spirit of prophecy His Institutes ought to be studied after the Heidelberg Catechism as containing a fuller explanation but with discrimination like the writings of all men During his life Calvin produced commentaries on 48 books of the Bible a total of 45 published volumes He intended to put out a complete commentary of the Bible but his death prevented this The books of Judges Ruth 1 2 Samuel 1 2 Kings 1 2 Chronicles Ezra Nehemiah Esther Job Proverbs Ecclesiastes Song of Solomon 2 3 John and Revelation were unfortunately not completed He did however write a two volume commentary of the Harmony of the Gospels Matthew Mark and Luke as well as a separate commentary for the gospel of John Likewise he also wrote a two volume series on the Harmony of the Law Exodus Leviticus Numbers and Deuteronomy Calvin s own exegesis of the original text allowed him to bring out a unique and pleasing interpretation He begins each section of scripture with his own translation of the text and then further expounds upon it point by point making it an excellent resource for ministers and teachers alike After more than 400 years Calvin s commentaries are still a relevant and essential tool for Christians
