Staatz, 2000 Mali a country rich with history and culture but one of the poorest in the world emerged in the 1990s as one of Africa's most vibrant democracies Strengthened by bold political and economic reforms at home Mali has emerged as a leader in African peace keeping efforts How has such a transition taken place How have these changes built on Mali s rich heritage These are the questions that the contributors to this volume have addressed During the past twenty five years the scholarly research and applied development work of Michigan State University faculty and students in Mali represents the most significant combined long term and continuing contribution of any group of university faculty in the United States or Europe to the study of Malian society economy and politics The applied nature of much of this work has resulted in a significant number of working papers reports and conference presentations This volume represents a coherent and connected set of essays from one American university with a widely known and highly respected role in African development While the essays identify and review Mali s unique historical and contemporary path to democracy and development they also contribute to the advancement of theoretical knowledge about African development Transitions and Consolidation of Democracy in Africa Samuel Ebow Quainoo, 2008 What conditions motivate a transition to democracy Can the dynamics of a transition influence its outcome Under what circumstances has democracy been consolidated in Africa This trilogy of questions has become necessary in light of the current democratic wave engulfing Africa and the rest of the world In examining the conditions that initiate democratic transitions this book investigates the circumstances under which democracy movements have operated between 1980 and 1990 It concludes that contrary to dominant democratic theory the transitions to democracy in Africa have occurred under declining levels of development With regard to transitions the book recognizes that they have their own dynamics Two main types of transitions are discerned top down and bottom up The book argues that in spite of the restrictive nature of top down transitions they offer a better opportunity for democratic consolidation because of the consensus between elites of the prodemocracy regime and their counterparts in the authoritarian regime a condition that is normally absent under bottom up transitions Finally relying on the cases of consolidated democracies the book derives an African democracy model The model delineates five main conditions that facilitate democratic consolidation including good leadership relevant political institutions external support civic space and a reasonable level of development It cautions however that these are not sufficient conditions nor are all of them necessary Since countries have unique historical circumstances specific countries will have to combine conditions in the model that are relevant to that society to consolidate its democracy The right combination will depend on the specific needs of the individual country **Democratic Trajectories in Africa** Danielle Resnick, Nicolas van de Walle, 2013-10-31 Despite impressive economic growth rates over the last decade foreign aid still plays a significant role in Africa's political economies This book asks when why and how foreign aid has facilitated or

hindered democratization in sub Saharan Africa Instead of looking at foreign aid as a monolithic resource the book examines the disparate impacts of aid specifically intended for development outcomes and aid explicitly aimed at democracy promotion Careful attention is also given to examining the role of various aid modalities including general budget support and the influence of non traditional donors In doing so the authors use a combination of cross country quantitative analyses and in depth case studies of Benin Ghana Malawi Mali Mozambique Tanzania and Zambia based on recent interviews with donors government officials and civil society organizations Unlike other work on aid and democracy the book carefully considers how foreign aid affects various elements of the democratization process including transitions to multiparty systems and democratic consolidation In terms of the latter the authors analyse what role different types of aid play in avoiding a breakdown of multiparty democracy or an erosion of civil liberties reinforcing parliaments and judiciaries promoting free and fair elections and a vibrant civil society and encouraging competitive party systems Overall the authors findings suggest that the best means for enhancing the effectiveness of aid for development outcomes is not always the most optimal way of promoting democratic consolidation and the book provides policy recommendations to try and reconcile these trade offs
