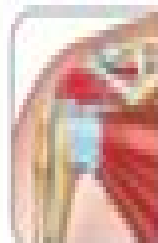


COMMON SHOULDER PROBLEMS



SUBACROMIAL BURSITIS

SYMPTOM

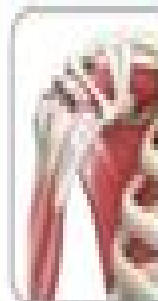
Inflammation and disturbance of the rotator cuff can lead to inflammation of the fluid that surrounds the subacromial bursa. As the arm is used, the bursa can become inflamed and become painful causing an **impingement syndrome**. The shoulder can become painful to move and sometimes.



ROTATOR CUFF SYNDROME

SYMPTOM

Any of the shoulder pathologies mentioned here can act as a cause for **rotator cuff syndrome** (bursitis). The rotator cuff is a group of four muscles that surround the shoulder joint and help to move the arm. **Rotator cuff syndrome** can involve pain and tenderness around the back and shoulder blade.



ROTATOR CUFF PATHOLOGY

SYMPTOM

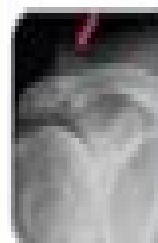
The rotator cuff is a group of four muscles that surround the shoulder joint providing movement and stability to the shoulder. Injury to the rotator cuff can cause **rotator cuff syndrome** causing the shoulder weak and painful to move. The rotator cuff is a group of four muscles that surround the shoulder joint and help to move the arm. The rotator cuff can suffer from **tendonitis**, **tears**, **impingement** or **rupture** depending on the type of rotator cuff pathology. Impingement is a common cause of rotator cuff pathology.



ACROMIOMETACARPAL JOINT PATHOLOGY

SYMPTOM

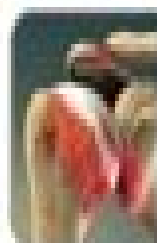
The shoulder is a ball and socket joint and is a ball joint sitting on a socket. There are various bones and structures around the ball and socket in the socket. These can be damaged through **trauma**, **overuse** and **inflammation** such as **impingement**. The separation of the shoulder joint is called **dislocation**. When the shoulder separates from the socket it is called **dislocation** and when the shoulder fully comes out of socket it is called **dislocation**. The shoulder dislocation is often very painful and requires special treatment to move the joint.



ACROMIOMETACARPAL JOINT PAIN

SYMPTOM

The acromiometacarpal joint (ACJ) is a joint that connects the upper arm to the trunk. It can become inflamed, irritated and painful from **overuse** or **trauma**. This is often caused by **trauma** or **overuse** of the joint or from a **fall** onto the shoulder.



ACROMIOMETACARPAL JOINT ARTHROSIS

SYMPTOM

Separation of the shoulder joint usually occurs later in life, as the joint is a **ball and socket joint**. However, **trauma** or **overuse** can cause the joint to become inflamed and painful. There can be **inflammation** and **pain** in movement of the shoulder.



LABRAL PATHOLOGY

SYMPTOM

The labrum is a piece of cartilage that lines the socket of the shoulder. It provides stability and balance to the shoulder joint. If the labrum is damaged or torn, it can cause **pain** and **instability** in the shoulder. The labrum can be damaged by **trauma** or **overuse** of the joint or from a **fall** onto the shoulder.

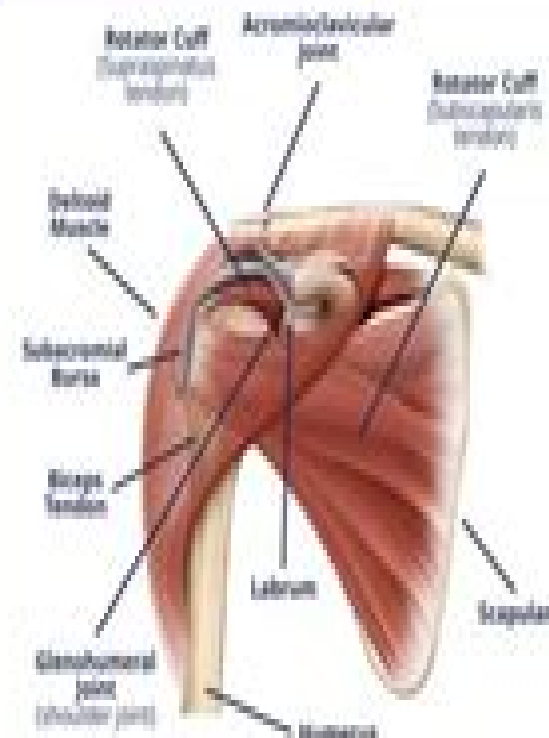


CAPSLITIS

SYMPTOM

The shoulder joint is a ball and socket joint and is a ball joint sitting on a socket. There are various bones and structures around the ball and socket in the socket. SHOULDER ANATOMY



COMMON SHOULDER SYMPTOMS INCLUDE:

- Pain on lifting the arm especially above shoulder height
- Pain with driving e.g., putting on coat, the strap
- Pain with household tasks e.g., mowing, lifting kettle
- Pain at night or lying on shoulder
- Weakness
- Clicking or crunching
- Instability sensations
- Restricted range of movement e.g., inability to lift arm above head or behind back
