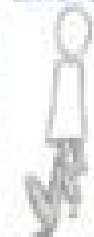

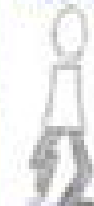

academic French subject matter such as life drawings portraits or compositional studies In the preface Butkin herself reinforces her taste by saying that drawings are much more personal and spontaneous than paintings often demonstrating the artistic process Foster curator of drawings at the Cleveland Museum and other scholars present a well researched volume that contributes new information to a very specialized field of art history It is greatly disappointing however that the bulk of the reproductions are in black and white often missing the subtly colored tones in many of the drawings Nonetheless this is recommended for museum and academic libraries that support graduate programs in art history 183 b w illustrations
