The Composition Matters Mr. Hui Tong, Shang-Jin Wei, 2009-08-01 We study whether capital flows affect the degree of credit crunch faced by a country's manufacturing firms during the 2007 09 crisis Examining 3823 firms in 24 emerging countries we find that the decline in stock prices was more severe for firms that are intrinsically more dependent on external finance for working capital The volume of capital flows has no significant effect on the severity of the credit crunch However the composition of capital flows
