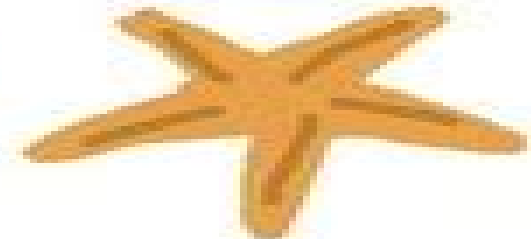

Key Characteristics:

- free-swimming larva to bottom-dwelling adult
- Most have 5 radii (pentamerous symmetry)
- Endoskeleton made of calcium plates
- Tube feet - aid in movement, feeding, respiration, excretion
- Nervous system but no brain/oesophagus
- Temperate - reproduce sexually and asexually

Structure + Function:

- Oral surface - underside of body
- Aboral surface - top of body
- Spines - sharp protective spines made of calcium plates



Water-Muscle System:

- Hydrostatic pressure permits movement
- Entry of Water - enters base plate, through aperture to the ring canal, then to the 5 radial canals
