Along the way, the author asks why Freud repressed his agoraphobia and examines literature, the work of architects and theorists including Le Corbusier, Walter Benjamin and R.D. Laing, artists such as Munch, Lapique and Giacometti and the German street films of the 1920s. He concludes by proposing a new way of regarding open space, a new

poetics of agoraphobia one that is sensitive to the agoraphobe's point of view and provides lessons for architects and urban planners today
