emphasizes the temporal patterns and potential for emergence in destructive relations Attractor deconstruction entails restoring complexity to a conflict scenario by isolating elements or changing the feedback loops among them The creation of a latent attractor trades on the tendency toward multi stability in dynamical systems and entails the consolidation of incongruent positive elements into a coherent structure In the bifurcation scenario factors are identified that can change the number and types of attractors in a conflict scenario The implementation of these strategies may hold the key to unlocking intractable conflict creating the potential for constructive social relations
