presented is that the ordinances and practices surrounding baptism present a framework for relations among child parents godparents church and city The design of the baptismal ceremony including liturgy participants and location provided a blueprint of the reformers vision of a well ordered community To comprehend fully the development and spread of Calvinism it is necessary to understand the context of its origins and how the ideas of Calvin and his Reformed colleagues were received in Geneva before they were disseminated throughout Europe and the world In a broad sense this project explores the tensions among church leaders city authorities parents relatives and neighbours regarding the upbringing of children in Reformed Geneva More specifically it studies the practice of infant baptism as manifested in the baptism ceremony in Geneva the ongoing practices of Catholic baptism in neighbouring areas and the similarities and tensions between these two rituals
