By asking whose city whose development, the Reader rigorously highlights the fractures along lines of class, race, gender, and other socially and spatially constructed hierarchies in global South cities. The Reader's thematic structure, where editorial introductions accompany selected texts, examines the issues and concerns that urban dwellers, planners, and policy makers face in the contemporary world. These include the urban economy, housing, basic services, infrastructure, the role of non-state civil society-based actors, planned interventions, and contestations, the role of diaspora capital, the looming problem of adapting to climate change, and the increasing spectre of violence in a post-9/11 transnational world. The *Cities of the Global South Reader* pulls together a diverse set of readings from scholars across the world, some of which have been written specially for the volume to provide an essential resource for a broad interdisciplinary readership at undergraduate and postgraduate levels in urban geography, urban sociology, and urban planning, as well as disciplines related to international and development studies. Editorial commentaries that introduce the central issues for each theme summarize the state of the field and outline an associated bibliography. They will be of particular value for lecturers, students, and researchers, making the *Cities of the Global South Reader* a key text for those interested in understanding contemporary urbanization processes.
