Ghost Dancing the Law John William Sayer, 1997 This study of the Wounded Knee trials demonstrates the impact that legal institutions and the media have on political dissent Sayer draws on court records news reports and interviews to show how both the defense and the prosecution had to respond continually to legal constraints media coverage and political events outside the courtroom *Ghost Dancing the Law* John William Sayer, 2001 *Ghost Dancing the Law* John William Sayer, 1997 After the siege ended at Wounded Knee the real battle had yet to be fought The 1973 standoff in South Dakota between Oglala Lakota Indians and federal lawmen led to the criminal prosecution of American Indian Movement leaders Dennis Banks and Russell Means The ten month trial had all the earmarks of a political tribunal with the defense led by William Kunstler and the prosecution backed by the Nixon administration it became a media battle for public opinion This first book length study of the Wounded Knee trials demonstrates the impact that legal institutions and the media have on political dissent It also shows how the dissenters as defendants can influence these institutions and the surrounding political and cultural climate AIM and its attorneys successfully turned the courtroom into a political forum on the history of U S Indian relations but were often frustrated in telling their story by the need to observe legal procedures and by the media's stereotyping them as Indian warriors or sixties militants John Sayer draws on court records news reports and interviews with participants to show how the defense and ultimately the prosecution had to respond continually to legal constraints media coverage and political events taking place outside the courtroom Although Banks and Means and most of the other protesters were acquitted Sayer notes that the confinement of AIM protests to the courtroom robbed the movement of considerable momentum *Ghost Dancing the Law* shows how legal proceedings can effectively quell dissent and represents both a critical chapter in the struggle of Native Americans and an important milestone at the crossroads of law and politics **Up Against the Law** Luca Falciola, 2022-09-15 As protest movements took to the streets during the 1960s and 1970s a group of lawyers joined forces with America's most confrontational activists In pursuit of radical change themselves these militant attorneys went beyond providing mere representation They identified with their clients defied the habits of a conservative profession and formulated a corrosive critique of the legal system questioning the neutrality and transformative power of law While exploiting the courtrooms as political forums they developed aggressive litigation strategies and became involved with the organization of protest Drawing on extensive archival research and interviews historian Luca Falciola reconstructs this largely unmapped phenomenon and challenges the reader to think anew about the pivotal role of lawyers in social movements At the heart of this book is the story of the National Lawyers Guild Founded in 1937 the Guild represented the first integrated and progressive bar association of America The Guild returned to prominence in the early 1960s at the vanguard providing legal aid to civil rights workers in the South Since then leftist students disobedient soldiers rebellious inmates radical minorities and revolutionary groups such as the Black Panther Party and the Weather Underground have

relied on this cadre of sympathetic lawyers to defend and empower them **William M. Kunstler** David J Langum, 1999-09-01 A vivid thoughtfully enthusiastic biography of the radical lawyer who defended such diverse clients as the Chicago Seven John Gotti Kirkus Throughout his career legendary civil rights lawyer William Kunstler has been alternately vilified as a publicity seeking egoist and lauded as a fearless advocate In this critical biography David Langum demonstrates that Kunstler consistently embodied both of these qualities He delighted in taking on fiercely political cases often representing society's outcasts and pariahs free of charge and achieving remarkable courtroom results in seemingly hopeless cases In the late 60s and the 70s Kunstler focused his attention on the Black Power and anti war movements He garnered public attention as defender of the Chicago Seven and went on to represent such controversial figures as Leonard Peltier the American Indian Movement leader charged with killing an FBI agent and Jack Ruby the killer of Lee Harvey Oswald Later Kunstler briefly represented Colin Ferguson the Long Island Railroad mass murderer outraging fans and detractors alike with his invocation of the infamous black rage defense What motivated Kunstler's obsessive craving for media attention his rhetorical flourishes in the courtroom and his instinctive and relentless drive for action How did Kunstler migrate from a comfortable middle class background to a life as a staunchly rebellious figure in social and legal history David Langum's portrait gives depth to the already notorious breadth of William Kunstler's life *Political Trials* Ron Christenson, 2017-12-02 Political trials take issues of responsibility conscience representation and legitimacy which are tied in tight political and legal knots and force us to face questions about our public identity our standards for public policy and our sense of history Ron Christenson explores how political trials especially those within the rule of law engage society's conflicting values and loyalties He examines numerous political trials throughout history bringing into question basic foundations of law politics and society Christenson classifies political trials according to the issues they generate in the political sphere partisan trials are spurious legal proceedings but politically expedient trials of corruption and insanity raise questions of public and personal responsibility trials of dissenters involve problems of conscience trials of nationalists highlight the nature of representation and the relationship of the part to the whole and trials of regimes engage the most fundamental concept of both law and politics legitimacy *Political Trials* brings these considerations to bear on some of the best known cases in history including the Gunpowder Plot the Spanish Inquisition the Dreyfus affair the Nuremberg trials trials of dissenters such as Socrates Thomas More Roger Williams and the Berrigan brothers and trials of nationalists such as Joan of Arc Gandhi Knut Hamsun and the Irish republicans Since the first edition appeared a number of notable political trials have raised critical issues for society Shocking public exposures about the Guildford 4 and Maguire 7 trials shook the British criminal justice establishment while in the United States trials concerning the beating of Rodney King led up to the O J Simpson spectacle and a host of parallel questions The trials of right wing terrorists such as Paul Hill found guilty of murdering an abortion doctor and Timothy McVeigh convicted of the Oklahoma City federal building bombing parallel

Remembering Defeat Andrew Wolpert, 2003-05-22 In 404 b c the Peloponnesian War finally came to an end when the Athenians starved into submission were forced to accept Sparta's terms of surrender Shortly afterwards a group of thirty conspirators with Spartan backing the Thirty overthrew the democracy and established a narrow oligarchy Although the oligarchs were in power for only thirteen months they killed more than 5 percent of the citizenry and terrorized the rest by confiscating the property of some and banishing many others Despite this brutality members of the democratic resistance movement that regained control of Athens came to terms with the oligarchs and agreed to an amnesty that protected collaborators from prosecution for all but the most severe crimes The war and subsequent reconciliation of Athenian society has been a rich field for historians of ancient Greece From a rhetorical and ideological standpoint this period is unique because of the extraordinary lengths to which the Athenians went to maintain peace In *Remembering Defeat* Andrew Wolpert claims that the peace was negotiated and constructed in civic discourse and not imposed upon the populace Rather than explaining why the reconciliation was successful as a way of shedding light on changes in Athenian ideology Wolpert uses public speeches of the early fourth century to consider how the Athenians confronted the troubling memories of defeat and civil war and how they explained to themselves an agreement that allowed the conspirators and their collaborators to go unpunished Encompassing rhetorical analysis trauma studies and recent scholarship on identity memory and law Wolpert's study sheds new light on a pivotal period in Athens history

Reinventing the Warrior Matthias André Voigt, 2024-09-01 On February 27 1973 a group of roughly 300 armed Indigenous men women and children seized the tiny hamlet of Wounded Knee South Dakota at gunpoint took hostages barricaded themselves in the hilltop church and raised an upside down American flag Taking place at the site of the infamous massacre in 1890 the highly symbolic confrontation spearheaded by the American Indian Movement AIM ultimately evolved into a prolonged seventy one day armed standoff between law enforcement officers and modern day Indigenous warriors Among these warriors were Vietnam War veterans armed with Vietnam era equipment and weaponry By organizing in defense of the newly proclaimed Independent Oglala Nation the AIM activists at Wounded Knee linked their nationalist quest for sovereignty and self determination with a warrior masculinity they constructed from a mix of Indigenous cultures and

contemporary cultural elements including the Black civil rights movement the counterculture of the 1960s and early 1970s and the antiwar movement As Matthias Andr Voigt shows the takeover of Wounded Knee was only one moment among many in the complex interplay between protest activism gender race and identity within AIM While AIM is widely recognized for its militancy and nationalism Reinventing the Warrior is the first major study to examine the gendered transformation of Indigenous men within the Red Power movement and the United States more generally AIM activists came to regard themselves like their ancestors before them as warriors fighting for their people their lands and their rights They sought to remasculinize their Indigenous identity in order to confront hegemonic masculinities and by implication colonialism itself By becoming more manly Indigenous men challenged the disempowering nature of white supremacy Voigt traces the story of the reinvention of Indigenous warriorhood from 1968 to the takeover of Wounded Knee in 1973 and beyond His trailblazing work explores why and how Indigenous men refashioned themselves as modern day warriors in their anticolonial nation building endeavor thereby remaking both self and society
