In attempting to wed learning and service, are we exploiting the other for new or recycled aims? As these questions attest of all types of service learning, international service learning (ISL) most starkly illuminates the tensions between the liberatory and oppressive potentials of practice. This book explores the ramifications of realizing a new age of service learning that pushes beyond single-episodic, course-based projects to rebalance student learning and community outcome priorities and provides insight into what it looks like in its execution. In describing eleven international programs designed to achieve reciprocal, sustained relationships in which learning is co-created, the

contributors reveal their struggles to change the balance of power relationships and move to a more transformative practice.
