educational process itself p 28 This book will be organized into two distinct sections The first section comprised of chapters that examine educational opportunity in rural districts from a micro level perspective is devoted to chapters that broadly examine the implications of state and federal policy on educational opportunity in rural schools and districts The second section which includes case studies of rural districts in the American South Appalachia and the Northeast takes a macro level approach to examining educational opportunity in rural districts Combined chapters throughout the book provide readers with both an overview and a specific snapshot of educational opportunity in rural schools Given the breadth and scope of chapters included in this volume we believe the book adds tremendously to the education policy literature as this vantage point has rarely been included in larger education policy discussions
