Ferkel,2016-09-19 In vivid step by step illustrative detail Foot and Ankle Arthroscopy Second Edition thoroughly describes arthroscopic techniques used in the surgical treatment of foot and ankle disorders Now fully up to date this edition details the advances that have affected the use of arthroscopy in foot and ankle surgery in recent years The text covers both the basics of equipment instrumentation and surgical anatomy as well as the practical steps surgeons must take to optimize results for each procedure **Historia de la Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología** Alejandro Lizaur Utrilla,Fernando Anacleto López Prats, Desde que el hombre fue consciente de su humanidad observó la presentación de enfermedades y accidentes preguntándose cuál era su causa y su posible remedio En todas las culturas antiguas pensaban que las enfermedades tenían un origen sobrenatural al ser dolencias internas o calamidades que parecían sobrevenir de manera espontánea sin que fuera visible o aparente el agente que las había causado De esta manera se achacaban a un origen divino como castigo o capricho de los dioses o bien a enemigos que utilizaban a los demonios o espíritus malignos por medio de la magia y la brujería Esta interpretación mágico-religiosa ha tenido una larga vigencia y aunque en menor medida ha convivido hasta nuestros días con la medicina científica en formatos y modalidades diversas Consecuentemente a este tipo de pensamiento en esas culturas primitivas se consideraba que la curación de las enfermedades sólo podía alcanzarse a través de medios sobrenaturales o divinos y por tanto los más capacitados para resolverlas eran los sacerdotes magos o hechiceros nicos con conocimientos de las fórmulas y ritos mágicos necesarios para interceder ante el dios contrarrestar las esencias malignas o ahuyentar a los espíritus causantes del mal Pero por otro lado observaron que las lesiones traumáticas tenían un origen natural siendo comprensible la relación entre la causa y el efecto Estas lesiones aunque siempre invocando la ayuda de algún dios benefactor no precisaban para su curación de recursos mágicos si no de medios naturales practicados por alguna persona ducha en tales menesteres sanadores Es decir el empirismo fue junto con las perspectivas de creencia la segunda de las perspectivas desde las que se basa la actividad sanadora Así la práctica de la medicina en las culturas arcaicas en cuanto a curación de las enfermedades estaba reservada a los sacerdotes al ser estos intelectualmente mejor formados y atribuirse dotes sanadoras concedidas por el dios Por el contrario la práctica de la cirugía abscesos heridas y traumatología fracturas luxaciones sólo requería aprendizaje y experiencia sin intervención divina pudiendo por tanto ser ejercida por gente sin instrucción religiosa y considerándose como un oficio manual de mucho menor rango social Esta es una de las razones del porqué la cirugía y su rama traumatología no tuvieron un progreso paralelo a la medicina hasta pocas recientes Ademas la cirugía y traumatología precisaban del conocimiento de la anatomía externa e interna pero la disección de cadáveres humanos estuvo largamente prohibida por la mayoría de las religiones incluidas las cristianas No es hasta el siglo XIX en que la cirugía

adquiere verdaderamente un fundamento científico moderno y prestigio profesional y social y no es hasta el siglo XX en que la Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología se convierte en especialidad independiente merced a los avances científicos y tecnológicos. La Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología es una rama desgajada de la Cirugía General y los comienzos de aquella son la historia de esta. La cirugía inicialmente fue considerada como una mera acción manual de ahí el origen etimológico de la palabra: *keir* mano, *ergon* obra, *keirourgeia* trabajo manual, es decir la realización de operaciones hechas con la mano o con instrumentos manuales con la finalidad de curar ciertas dolencias. La cirugía tuvo un pasado de cierta importancia entre los siglos XII y XV de la Edad Media. Los cirujanos medievales de la escuela italiana llegaron a practicar técnicas antísticas y los cirujanos franceses del siglo XIV en particular Guy de Chauliac utilizaron incluso un método de anestesia. El progreso quirúrgico alcanzó esplendor en el Renacimiento merced al avance de la Anatomía donde destacó Vesalio en la Universidad de Padua. Fue durante la Ilustración mediados del siglo XVIII cuando la cirugía pasó verdaderamente su quehacer en conocimientos científicos destacando el inglés John Hunter como una figura clave para el desarrollo de la Patología Quirúrgica General. Durante el siglo XIX la cirugía recuperó su puesto como rama de la Medicina primero en forma de Cirugía General; el cirujano actuaba sobre una afección quirúrgica de cualquier parte del cuerpo. A medida que los conocimientos aumentaron se fueron desgajando ramas del tronco lo que representó a su vez un estímulo para su progreso. Durante ese siglo la cirugía entró plenamente en la universidad y se desarrolló apoyándose en el avance de las llamadas Ciencias Básicas morfológicas y fisiológicas para sentar los cimientos de lo que sería la Cirugía del siglo XX. El cirujano dejó de ser un mero amanuense ayudante colaborador del médico para pasar a ser poseedor de un saber científico, patólogo y conocedor de un saber hacer. Técnicas los cuales debía aplicar con cierto virtuosismo habilidad y eficacia. El empleo de tales recursos necesitaba una experiencia Empirismo y su fin último era la curación del hombre enfermo. Humanismo. Por ello la cirugía es Ciencia, Técnica, Arte, Empirismo y Humanismo. El cirujano imprescindiblemente debe iniciarse en la Anatomía, Fisiología y la Bioquímica antes de comenzar a aplicar la técnica. De muy antiguo se distinguió la Oftalmología, Otorrinolaringología y Ginecología y la Obstetricia de la Cirugía General. Sin embargo el gran avance experimentado en las técnicas diagnósticas y los procedimientos terapéuticos durante el siglo XX dio lugar al fraccionamiento del rea de conocimiento de la cirugía en una serie de subáreas especializadas con cuerpo de doctrina propio. Así en la década de los sesenta del siglo XX aparecen las especialidades de Cirugía Cardiovascular, Cirugía Torácica, Cirugía Plástica y Reparadora, Cirugía Pediátrica, Urología y algo más tarde la Neurocirugía y la Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología. El término Ortopedia fue acuñado por el francés Nicolás Andry en 1741 como título de su libro sobre la prevención y corrección de deformidades en los niños. Ese término proviene etimológicamente de las palabras griegas *orthos* derecho, *recto* y *paideia*, infancia del niño, cuya traducción al latín es *orthopaedia*. En dicho libro apareció una imagen representando la corrección de las deformidades como un ríbola con un tutor para enderezar su tronco lo cual ha pasado a ser el símbolo de la Cirugía Ortopédica. El término Traumatología proviene de otras dos palabras griegas: *trauma*

herida ya en los escritos hipocráticos y logia estudio La especialización es un hecho necesario dada la capacidad limitada del hombre y ello redundó en una mejor atención al paciente y en mejorar la calidad y profundidad de la investigación A esta especialización se le pueden realizar dos objeciones La especialización no debe realizarse en detrimento de la visión del conjunto que supone el hombre enfermo limitándose al aparato o sistema alterado y obviando las numerosas conexiones que tienen entre sí las especialidades quirúrgicas Otra objeción viene dada desde el punto de vista académico En España a la universidad se ha asociado tradicionalmente a la generalidad y la profundidad de conocimientos se ha asociado a profesionales extrauniversitarios Afortunadamente esto se fue corrigiendo gracias a la labor de eminentes profesores que se dedicaron a reas quirúrgicas concretas y a la creación de Catedras de diversas especialidades quirúrgicas ampliando las reas de conocimiento académico Segundo Amor y Macau la razón que ha impulsado más la especialización es el acercamiento de la ciencia y de la técnica que han llegado incluso a confundirse El cirujano ha pasado en poco tiempo del ejercicio exclusivo de su habilidad manual a la adopción de técnicas que requieren la utilización de unos medios instrumentales quirúrgicos muy extensos y en constante evolución Esto hace difícil que un profesional pueda reunir todos los conocimientos y experiencias para estar al corriente y dominar todas las técnicas de su especialidad Actualmente la Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología es definida como la especialidad que trata de las afecciones móndicas y quirúrgicas del Sistema Locomotor por medios móndicos quirúrgicos y fisiológicos Así es una especialidad médica y quirúrgica Si bien su desarrollo actual se debió a las consecuencias de la Primera Guerra Mundial gracias al fulgurante progreso técnico de las ltimas décadas es una cirugía de vanguardia y ocupa en todo el mundo un lugar respetado Al ser también una cirugía con aplicación rutinaria sobre grandes masas de población tiene una influencia considerable en sus consecuencias móndicas sociales profesionales económicas y humanas Esta obra es un discreto tributo de los autores a su Especialidad para que su desarrollo histórico no sea olvidado por las futuras generaciones de especialistas y con la aspiración de que sirva de referencia y consulta a las mismas Nosotros no somos autoridades en la Historia de la Medicina si no meros aficionados con una elevada ilusión en aportar esta compilación de lo conocido y a nuestro alcance Si bien la ahora llamada Cirugía General fue la base para el desarrollo de la Cirugía Ortopédica y Traumatología esta obra se centra específicamente en esta última especialidad por obvia razón de espacio y extensión Los autores en Elche 2022
