

the intrusion of the Osiris faith and the Osirian editing by the hand of the earliest redactor in literary history all these and many other fundamental disclosures of this earliest body of literature have hitherto been inaccessible to the English reader and as far as they are new also to all It was therefore with peculiar pleasure that just after the appearance of Sethe's edition of the Pyramid Texts I received President Francis Brown s very cordial invitation to deliver the Morse Lectures at Union Theological Seminary on some subject in Egyptian life and civilization While it was obviously desirable at this juncture to choose a subject which would involve some account of the Pyramid Texts it was equally desirable to assign them their proper place in the development of Egyptian civilization This latter desideratum led to a rather more ambitious subject than the time available before the delivery of the lectures would permit to treat exhaustively viz to trace the development of Egyptian religion in its relation to life and thought as for example it has been done for the Hebrews by modern critical and historical study In the study of Egyptian religion hitherto the effort has perhaps necessarily been to produce a kind of historical encyclopedia of the subject Owing to their vast extent the mere bulk of the materials available this method of study and presentation has resulted in a very complicated and detailed picture in which the great drift of the development as the successive forces of civilization dominated has not been discernible.
