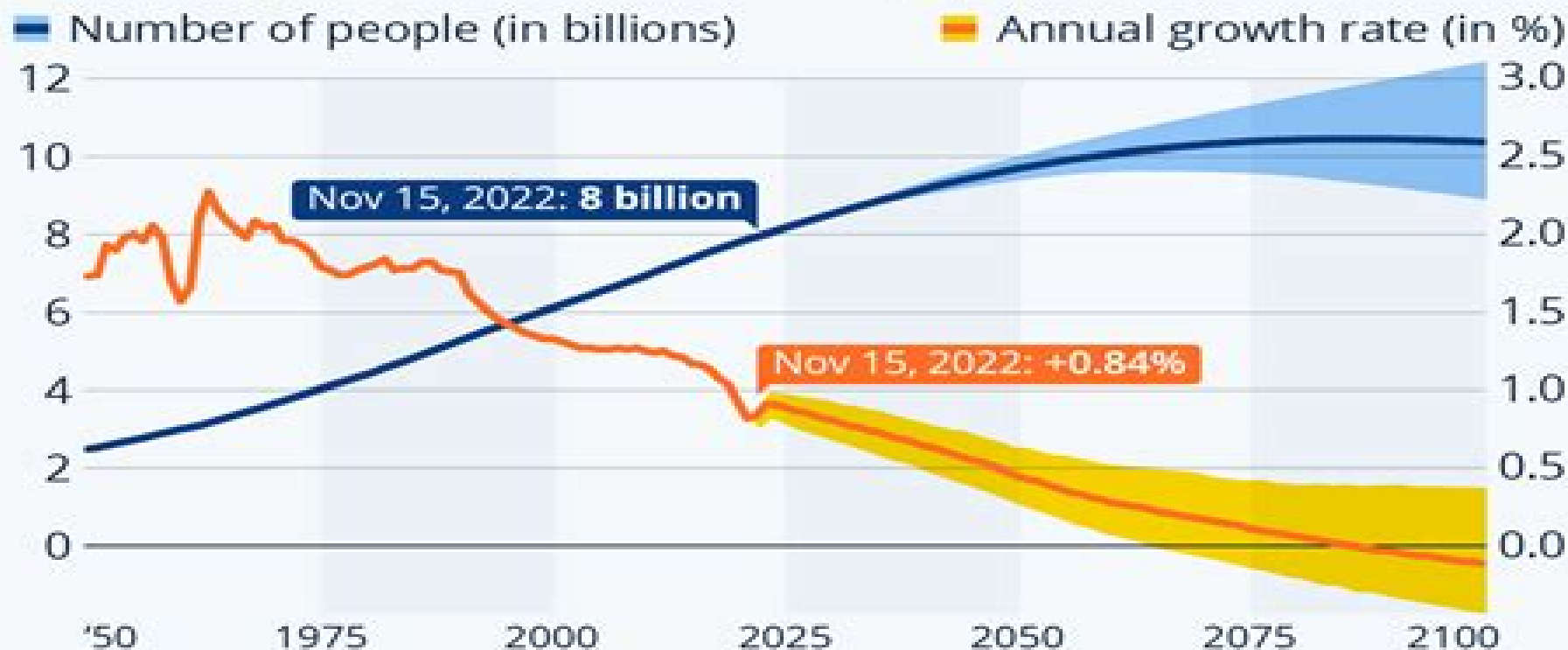


World Population Reaches 8 Billion

relationships among women's survival rates at reproductive age the theoretical fertility rate to maintain the replacement level and the recorded total fertility rate TFR were analyzed Historical observation showed TFR adapting to the theoretical level of fertility with a certain time lag and corresponding to women's survival rates at reproductive age Women's increasing lifespan and survival rates could have influenced decision making to minimize the risk of childbearing Even if the theoretical fertility rate meets the replacement level women's views of minimizing the risk may remain unchanged because for women the cost benefit imbalance in childbearing is still too high in Japan Based on the findings the author discusses the sustainability of Japanese society in relation to national finances social security reform family policies immigration policies and community policies
