**Civilian Immunity in War** Igor Primoratz, 2007-10-04 The protection of noncombatants from deadly violence is the centrepiece of any account of ethical and legal constraints on war It was a major achievement of moral progress from early modern times to World War I Yet it has been under constant attrition since perhaps never more so than in our time with its new wars the spectre of weapons of mass destruction and the global terrorism alert Civilian Immunity in War presents eleven specially written essays on the main aspects of this highly topical subject Written in a clear and non technical style this volume will appeal to students and researchers in philosophy politics and law as well as anyone with an interest in the ethics and legality of war

Grey, 2017-07-05 The status of the civilian today is that of a calculated casualty to die immediately or after agonizing suffering The civilian is also a hostage in the political power struggle since his continued safety depends upon the decision or even impulse of his leaders This is true if he is a citizen of a major power or if he lives elsewhere in unstable social and political environments Hartigan s book is a unique effort to deal with a mass but hidden problem the status of the civilian non combatant in conditions of armed conflict Civilian Victims in War fills the gaps in our knowledge of the origins of civilian immunity so that a full evaluation of the principle s continued worth may be made The book reviews the concepts of noncombatants civilian immunity how it arose from need and intuition and developed into legal practice The volume focuses on the development of this concept in the Western tradition not because civilian immunity was absent in Asia or Africa but because its present formulation owes its origin and elaboration to European custom practice and thought Civilian Victims in War is the first book to deal with the central theme of the innocent non combatant Hartigan seeks to pursue this subject in greater depth and asks the intelligent layman to reconsider his or her options in the face of modern warfare He touches on many subjects in this work which will spark interest with the general public and policy personnel those who should recognize themselves as civilians and see this book as their tragic history

**Weaponizing Civilian Protection** Thomas Gregory, 2025-01-18 Weaponizing Civilian Protection exposes how coalition efforts to minimize and mitigate civilian casualties during the recent conflict in Afghanistan also worked to rationalize the harm inflicted upon Afghan civilians Drawing on declassified documents and interviews with coalition officials it traces how civilian protection was reimagined as a martial tactic rather than a humanitarian imperative with coalition officials reframing civilian casualties as strategic setbacks that could imperil the entire mission This book examines the restrictions that coalition officials imposed on combat operations to minimize unnecessary harm to civilians whilst showing how these restrictions served to constitute civilian casualties as necessary in certain situations rendering their lives losable and their deaths ungrievable At the same time it examines the post incident mitigation measures coalition officials used to prevent civilian casualties becoming strategic setbacks including the condolence payments that were offered when civilians were

harmed Rather than seeking to make amends for the harm inflicted upon them it claims that these post incident mitigation measures are best characterized as a necropolitical device concerned with managing mortality more effectively Crucially Weaponizing Civilian Protection shows that co opting civilian protection into a martial logic that is more concerned with winning wars than protecting the civilian population works to devalue and dehumanize civilians leaving them more

vulnerable to death and destruction in future conflicts      **Gender and Civilian Victimization in War** Jessica L. Peet, Laura Sjoberg, 2019-11-25 This book explores the role of gender in influencing war fighting actors strategies toward the attack or protection of civilians Traditional narratives suggest that killing civilians intentionally in wars happens infrequently and that the perpetration of civilian targeting is limited to aberrant actors Recently scholars have shown that both state and non state actors target civilians even while explicitly deferring to the civilian immunity principle This book fills a gap in the accounts of how civilian targeting happens and shows that these actors are in large part targeting women rather than some gender neutral understanding of civilians It presents a history of civilian victimization in wars and conflicts and then lays out a feminist theoretical approach to understanding civilian victimization It explores the British Blockade of Germany in World War I the Soviet Rape of Berlin in World War II the Rwandan genocide and the contemporary conflict in northeast Nigeria Across these case studies the authors lay out that gender is key to how war fighting actors understand both themselves and their opponents and therefore plays a role in shaping strategic and tactical choices It makes the argument that seeing women in nationalist and war narratives is crucial to understanding when and how civilians come to be targeted in wars and how that targeting can be reduced This book will be of much interest to students of critical security gender studies war studies and International Relations in general      **War By Agreement** Yitzhak Benbaji, Daniel Statman, 2019-10-03 War by

**Shooting to Kill** Seumas Miller, 2016 Terrorism the use of military force in Afghanistan Iraq and Syria and the fatal police shootings of unarmed persons have all contributed to renewed interest in the ethics of police and military use of lethal force and its moral justification In this book philosopher Seumas Miller analyzes the various moral justifications and moral responsibilities involved in the use of lethal force by police and military combatants relying on a distinctive normative teleological account of institutional roles His conception constitutes a novel alternative to prevailing reductive individualist and collectivist accounts As Miller argues police and military uses of lethal force are morally justified in part by recourse to fundamental natural moral rights and obligations especially the right to personal self defense and the moral obligation to defend the lives of innocent others Yet the moral justification for police and military use of lethal force is to some extent role specific Both police officers and military combatants evidently have an institutionally based moral duty to put themselves in harm s way to protect others Under some circumstances however police have an institutionally based moral duty to use lethal force to uphold the law and military combatants have an institutionally based moral duty to use lethal force to win wars Two key notions in play are joint action and the natural right to self defense Miller uses a relational individualist theory of joint actions to construct the notion of multi layered structures of joint action in order to explicate organizational action He also provides a novel theory of justifiable killing in self defense Over the course of his book Miller covers a variety of urgent topics such as police shootings of armed offenders police shooting of suicide bombers targeted killing autonomous weapons humanitarian armed intervention and civilian immunity

**The Future of Just War** Caron E. Gentry, Amy E. Eckert, 2014-01-15 Just War scholarship has adapted to contemporary crises and situations But its adaptation
