These problems while apparent to those who work in the field are largely hidden from public view in part because popular fictional television programs frequently depict the emergency care system in fine shape Despite the lifesaving feats performed every day by emergency departments and ambulance services the nation s emergency medical system as a whole is overburdened underfunded and highly fragmented The IOM received funding from 14 organizations to conduct a series of dissemination workshops associated with the release of the 2006 reports on the future of emergency care Three one day regional dissemination workshops were conducted in Salt Lake City Utah September 7 2006 Chicago Ilinois October 27 2006 and New Orleans Louisiana November 2 2006 Each of the workshops featured focused discussions in two issue areas The meeting in Salt Lake City focused on pediatric emergency
