create a highly readable and accessible story allowing us to hear the voices of all the protagonists She also presents the issues evenhandedly effectively balancing her presentation of arguments by both the plaintiffs and the schools that sought to continue the segregation of Mexican American students Ultimately Mendez highlights how Mexican Americans took the lead to secure their civil rights and demonstrates how organization courage and persistence in the Mexican American communities could overcome the racism of the school boards Their inspiring example is particularly timely given the current controversies over immigration and the growing national interest in Latino life
