He singles out Cynthia Ozick as one of the few American writers who can meet the challenge of imagining mass murder without flinching and who can distinguish between myth and truth. On the other hand he finds Bernard Malamud's literary treatment of the Holocaust never entirely successful it seems to have been a threat to Malamud's vision of man's basic dignity and he argues that William Styron's portrayal of the commandant of Auschwitz in Sophie's Choice pushed Nazi violence to the periphery of the novel where it disturbed neither the author nor his readers. He is especially acute in his discussion of the language used to describe the Holocaust arguing that much of it is used to console rather than to confront. He notes that when we speak of the survivor instead of the victim of martyrdom instead of murder regard being gassed as dying with dignity or evoke the redemptive rather than grievous power.
