Keeping the Immigrant Bargain Vivian Louie,2012-06-01 Most nineteenth and early twentieth century European immigrants arrived in the United States with barely more than the clothes on their backs They performed menial jobs spoke little English and often faced a hostile reception But two or more generations later the overwhelming majority of their descendants had successfully integrated into American society Today s immigrants face many of the same challenges but some experts worry that their integration especially among Latinos will not be as successful as their European counterparts *Keeping the Immigrant Bargain* examines the journey of Dominican and Colombian newcomers whose children have achieved academic success one generation after the arrival of their parents Sociologist Vivian Louie provides a much needed comparison of how both parents and children understand the immigrant journey toward education mobility and assimilation Based on Louie s own survey and interview study *Keeping the Immigrant Bargain* examines the lives of thirty seven foreign born Dominican and Colombian parents and their seventy six young adult offspring the majority of whom were

enrolled in or had graduated from college The book shows how they are adapting to American schools jobs neighborhoods and culture Louie discovers that before coming to the United States some of these parents had already achieved higher levels of education than the average foreign born Dominican or Colombian and after arrival many owned their own homes Significantly most parents in each group expressed optimism about their potential to succeed in the United States while also expressing pessimism about whether they would ever be accepted as Americans In contrast to the social exclusion experienced by their parents most of the young adults had assimilated linguistically and believed themselves to be full participants in American society Keeping the Immigrant Bargain shows that the offspring of these largely working class immigrants had several factors in common that aided their mobility Their parents were highly engaged in their lives and educational progress although not always in ways expected by schools or their children and the children possessed a strong degree of self motivation Equally important was the availability of key institutional networks of support including teachers peers afterschool and other enrichment programs and informal mentors outside of the classroom These institutional networks gave the children the guidance they needed to succeed in school offering information the parents often did not know themselves While not all immigrants achieve such rapid success this engrossing study shows how powerful the combination of self motivation engaged families and strong institutional support can be Keeping the Immigrant Bargain makes the case that institutional relationships such as teachers and principals who are trained to accommodate cultural difference and community organizations that help parents and children learn how to navigate the system can bear significantly on immigrant educational success

group In *Stagnant Dreamers* sociologist and social policy expert Mar a Rend n follows 42 young men from two high poverty Los Angeles neighborhoods as they transition into adulthood Based on in depth interviews and ethnographic observations with them and their immigrant parents *Stagnant Dreamers* describes the challenges they face coming of age in the inner city and accessing higher education and good jobs and demonstrates how family based social ties and community institutions can serve as buffers against neighborhood violence chronic poverty incarceration and other negative outcomes Neighborhoods in East and South Central Los Angeles were sites of acute gang violence that peaked in the 1990s shattering any romantic notions of American life held by the immigrant parents Yet Rend n finds that their children are generally optimistic about their life chances and determined to make good on their parents sacrifices Most are strongly oriented towards work But despite high rates of employment most earn modest wages and rely on kinship networks for labor market connections Those who made social connections outside of their family and neighborhood contexts more often found higher quality jobs However a middle class lifestyle remains elusive for most even for college graduates Rend n debunks fears of downward assimilation among second generation Latinos noting that most of her subjects were employed and many had gone on to college She questions the ability of institutions of higher education to fully integrate low income students of color She shares the story of one Ivy League college graduate who finds himself working in the same low wage jobs as his parents and peers who did not attend college Ironically students who leave their neighborhoods to pursue higher education are often the most exposed to racism discrimination and classism Rend n demonstrates the importance of social supports in helping second generation immigrant youth succeed To further the integration of second generation Latinos she suggests investing in community organizations combating criminalization of Latino youth and fully integrating them into higher education institutions *Stagnant Dreamers* presents a realistic yet hopeful account of how the Latino second generation is attempting to realize its vision of the American dream

Redefining Race Dina G. Okamoto, 2014-09-25 In 2012 the Pew Research Center issued a report that named Asian Americans as the highest income best educated and fastest growing racial group in the United States Despite this seemingly optimistic conclusion over thirty Asian American advocacy groups challenged the findings As many pointed out the term Asian American itself is complicated It currently denotes a wide range of ethnicities national origins and languages and encompasses a number of significant economic and social disparities In *Redefining Race* sociologist Dina G Okamoto traces the complex evolution of this racial designation to show how the use of Asian American as a panethnic label and identity has been a deliberate social achievement negotiated by members of this group themselves rather than an organic and inevitable process Drawing on original research and a series of interviews Okamoto investigates how different Asian ethnic groups in the U S were able to create a collective identity in the wake of the Civil Rights movement in the 1960s Okamoto argues that a variety of broad social forces created the conditions for this developing panethnic identity Racial segregation for example shaped how Asian immigrants of different national origins were distributed

in similar occupations and industries This segregation of Asians within local labor markets produced a shared experience of racial discrimination which encouraged Asian ethnic groups to develop shared interests and identities By constructing a panethnic label and identity ethnic group members took part in creating their own collective histories and in the process challenged and redefined current notions of race The emergence of a panethnic racial identity also depended somewhat paradoxically on different groups organizing along distinct ethnic lines in order to gain recognition and rights from the larger society According to Okamoto these ethnic organizations provided the foundation necessary to build solidarity within different Asian origin communities Leaders and community members who created inclusive narratives and advocated policies that benefited groups beyond their own were then able to move these discrete ethnic organizations toward a panethnic model For example a number of ethnic specific organizations in San Francisco expanded their services and programs to include other ethnic group members after their original constituencies dwindled A Laotian organization included refugees from different parts of Asia a Japanese organization began to advocate for South Asian populations and a Chinese organization opened its doors to Filipinos and Vietnamese As Okamoto argues the process of building ties between ethnic communities while also recognizing ethnic diversity is the hallmark of panethnicity *Redefining Race* is a groundbreaking analysis of the processes through which group boundaries are drawn and contested In mapping the genesis of a panethnic Asian American identity Okamoto illustrates the ways in which concepts of race continue to shape how ethnic and immigrant groups view themselves and organize for representation in the public arena
