

Chapter 1

Effective Family Communication for Coping with Crises

Families inevitably experience crises. Recent events including the Gulf Oil Spill, Hurricane Katrina, and the Iraq War demonstrate how trouble simply “happens.” Internal events such as divorce, death, and illness also can strike unexpectedly and threaten the well-being of the family. While people typically cannot control nor prevent negative events, they often turn to their families for support as they attempt to manage the aftermath of such crises. Effective management of unexpected negative events necessarily involves effective crisis communication within families. This book provides a collection of carefully selected essays describing how families effectively communicate during crises.

For purposes of this book, we adopted Baxter and Braithwaite’s (2006) definition of family as “a social group of two or more persons characterized by ongoing interdependence with long-term commitments that stem from blood, law, or affection” (p. 3) and their definition of communication as “symbol use between persons through verbal and nonverbal means” (p. 3). We conceptualized a crisis as an unexpected, negative event that does not allow the family to continue functioning in their usual manner; further, we note that most families are unprepared for crises and find addressing such circumstances both challenging and stressful.

This chapter introduces the book via five major sections. First, we describe the development of the scholarly specialty area of family communication to provide an understanding of the intellectual development that lead to this book. Second, we describe the book as a whole—its development, goals, and contributions. Third, we advise scholars, teachers, and practitioners on how to use this book. Fourth, we preview the individual chapters. Finally, we describe effective coping strategies for families in crisis.
