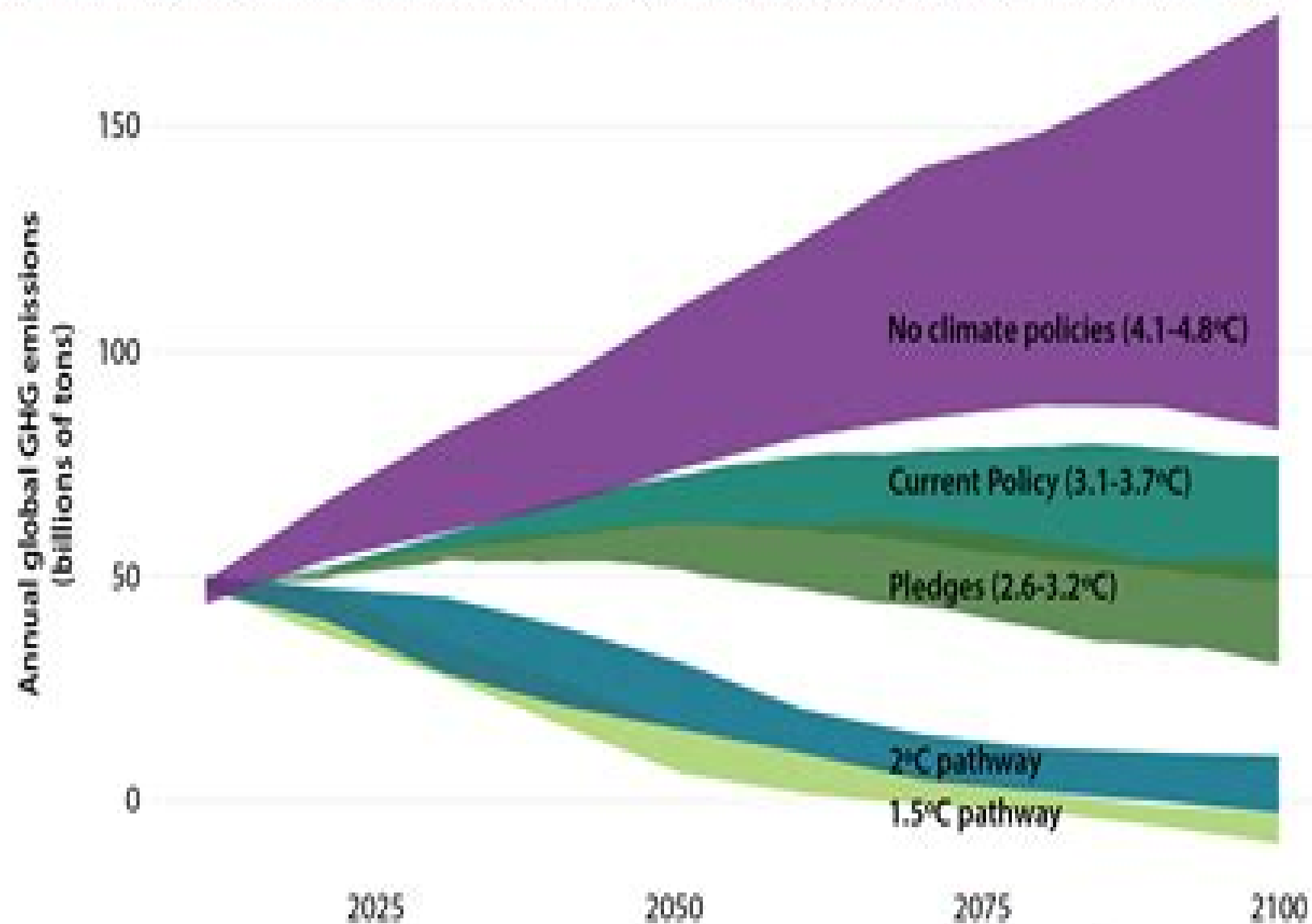


Historical and Projected Annual Global GHG Emissions under Selected Policy Scenarios, 2010–2100
