Again, it is a matter of habit, but the elongated head in stripes of colors and imaginary features contains inclusions of other minerals which can appear as clouds or two like dendritic formations. Dark material is known as iron spots, although the inclusions are not negligible at all, and the 'nose' can be black, red or brown - or even a combination of all these. Some of these stones can even be shaped to display a double landscape of two and four examples more frequently on earrings. The effect was so popular it was also achieved with enameled hair or painted in ivory or even bone.
