Cuando ya a cierta edad dejé mi primera profesión el derecho la función pública para pasar a la Universidad y dedicarme a la Historia siguiendo mi vocación profunda dediqué mis primeros ensayos a temas como el retorno del individuo el auge de la biografía la narratividad las aportaciones del pensamiento histórico de Paul Veyne y Paul Ricoeur la crítica de la teoría marxista. No despertaron salvo en el profesor Jover interese e incluso algún catedrático de mi Departamento parece haber comentado eso en tono amable pero estas cosas que hace Antonio son realmente historia. Alguno de estos trabajos llegó a manos de Olbarri y a él debo la primera invitación profesional que recibí para pronunciar una conferencia. Me invitó Pamplona donde tuve un seminario en el que participaron entre otros los profesores Valentín Vázquez de Prada y Agustín González Enciso. Significó mucho para mí. Es muy difícil trabajar sin un mínimo reconocimiento a lo que uno hace. Mas lo que confiere a Olbarri rango ejemplar es el valor moral. Para sobrellevar muy difíciles circunstancias personales pero también para estar en el medio profesional. Valor hace falta para no conformarse evitando problemas con las ideas dominantes para enfrentarse con dogmatismos e incomprendiones para no seguir caminos trillados. Ciertamente mucho antes del fin del socialismo real era visible en el panorama intelectual europeo un cierto malestar ante un pensamiento marxista presuntamente científico humus en el que debía echar raíces todo pensamiento. Sartre pero que se había convertido en una escolástica académica que impregnaba el ambiente universitario. Así el concepto de relaciones laborales de Olbarri se dijo tenía un tuflillo de organización sindical del franquismo. No sigamos no sin decir que la historiografía de los últimos cuarenta años más o menos no debe verse como un río que discurre apaciblemente aumentado por los más varios caudales. Corrientes y remolinos agitaron las aguas. La historia de la historiografía española debe en ciertos aspectos empezando por su propio contenido replantearse. Creo que ya se está haciendo. En fin la actitud como polemista de Olbarri es perpetua inquieto e inconformista y desde la creencia de que sólo con el permanente debate progresa la ciencia ha sido siempre abierta intelectualmente y respetuosa con quien pensaba de distinta manera y al que nunca generosamente negaba sus méritos.
