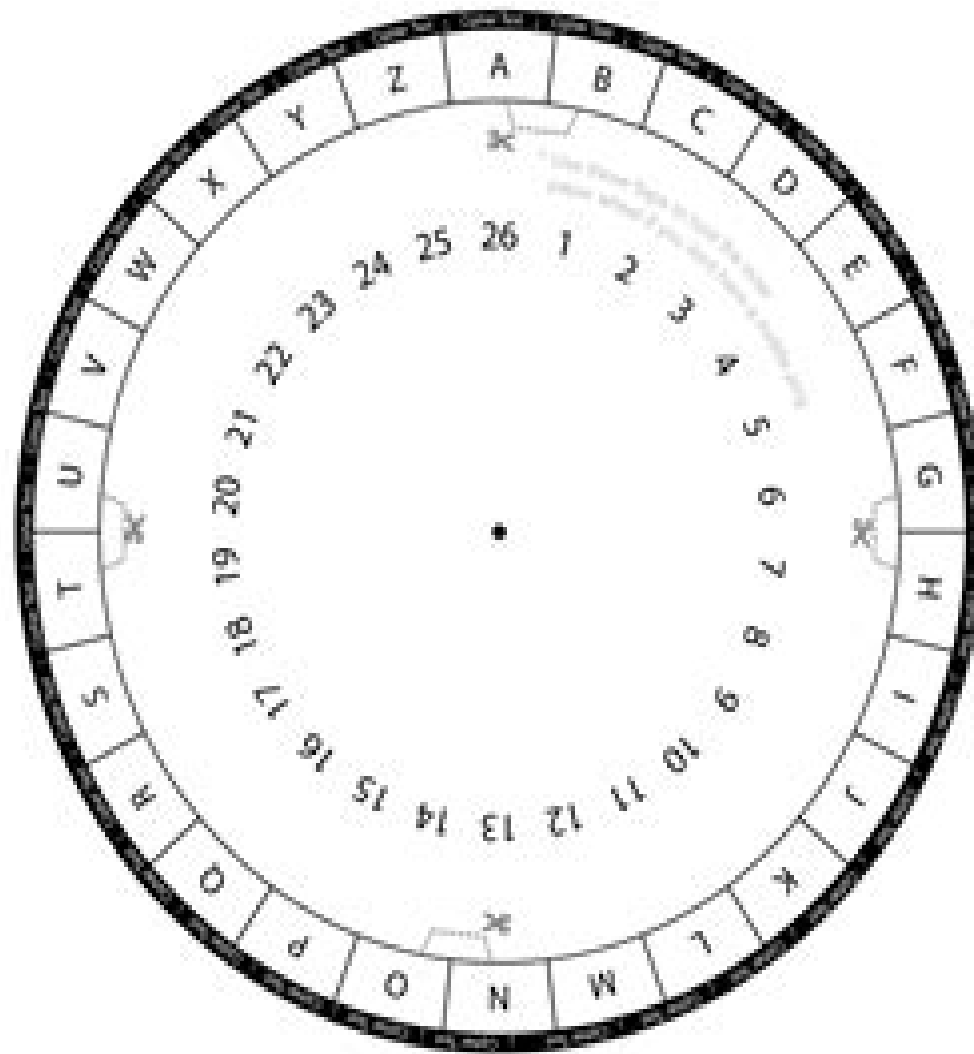

The project ended with plausible identification candidates for 121 of 126 herbal section plants and 7 others elsewhere in the manuscript far beyond that of other published solutions. An incredible 100% of the 133 identified plants have dermatological uses. These can be divided into prominent subtopics like treatment of bites, anthelmintics, rheumatism and other musculo-skeletal ailments, inflammatory skin disorders, external and possibly
