**Descriptive Adaptation Studies** Patrick Cattrysse, 2014-02-18 It is common practice nowadays for adaptation critics to denounce the lack of meta theoretical thinking in adaptation studies and to plead for a study of adaptation as adaptation one that eschews value judgments steps beyond normative fidelity based discourse examines adaptation from an intertextual perspective and abandons the single source model for a multiple source model This study looks into a research program that does all that and more It was developed in the late 1980s and presented in the early 1990s as a polysystem PS study of adaptations Since then the PS label has been replaced with descriptive This book studies the question of whether and how a PS approach could evolve into a descriptive adaptation studies DAS approach Although not perfect no method is DAS offers a number of assets Apart from dealing with the above mentioned issues DAS transcends an Auteurist approach and looks at explanation beyond the level of individual agency even if contextualized As an alternative to the endless accumulation of ad hoc case studies it suggests corpus based research into wider trends of adaptational behavior and the roles and functions of sets of adaptations DAS also allows reflection upon its own epistemic values It sheds new light on some old issues How can one define adaptation What does it mean to study adaptation as adaptation Is equivalence still possible and is the concept still relevant DAS also tackles some deeper epistemological issues How can phenomena be compared Why would difference be more real than sameness or change more real than stasis How does description relate to evaluation explanation and prediction etc This book addresses both theory minded scholars who are interested in epistemological reflection and practice oriented adaptation students who want to get started From a theoretical point of view it discusses arguments that could support the legitimacy of adaptation studies as an academic discipline From a practical point of view it explains in general terms ways of conducting an adaptation study Patrick Cattrysse's work is of utmost importance to Adaptation Studies As the first extended attempt to develop a rigorous methodology which borrows in

Investigating the Role of Emotions, Self-Centered Motives, and Social Norms Corrado Corradi-Dell'Acqua, Leonie Koban, Susanne Leiberg, Patrik Vuilleumier, Ernst Fehr, 2016-09-28 Human behavior and decision making is subject to social and motivational influences such as emotions norms and self other regarding preferences The identification of the neural and psychological mechanisms underlying these factors is a central issue in psychology behavioral economics and social neuroscience with important clinical social and even political implications However despite a continuously growing interest from the scientific community the processes underlying these factors as well as their ontogenetic and phylogenetic development have so far remained elusive In this Research Topic we collect articles that provide challenging insights and stimulate a fruitful controversy on the question of what determines social behavior Indeed over the last decades research has shown that introducing a social context to otherwise abstract tasks has diverse effects on social behavior On the one hand it may induce individuals to act irrationally for instance to refuse money but on the other hand it improves individuals reasoning in that formerly difficult abstract problems can be easily solved These lines of research led to distinct although not necessarily mutually exclusive models for socially driven behavioral changes For instance a popular theoretical framework interprets human behavior as a result of a conflict between cognition and emotion with the cognitive system promoting self interested choices and the emotional system triggered by the social context operating against them Other theories favor social norms and deontic heuristics in biasing human reasoning and encouraging choices that are sometimes in conflict with one's interest Few studies attempted to disentangle between these as well as other models As a consequence although insightful results arise from specific domains tasks a comprehensive theoretical framework is still missing Furthermore studies employing neuroimaging techniques have begun to shed some light on the neural substrates involved in social behavior implicating consistently although not exclusively portions of the limbic system the insular and the prefrontal cortex In this context a challenge for present research lies not only in further mapping the brain structures implicated in social behavior or in describing in detail the functional interaction between these structures but in showing how the implicated networks relate to different theoretical models This is Research Topic hosted by members of the Swiss National Center of Competence in Research Affective Sciences Emotions in Individual Behaviour and Social Processes We collected contributions from the international community which extended the current

knowledge about the psychological and neural structures underlying social behavior and decision making In particular we encouraged submissions from investigators arising from different domains psychology behavioral economics affective sciences etc implementing different techniques behavior electrophysiology neuroimaging brain stimulations on different populations neurotypical adults children brain damaged or psychiatric patients etc Animal studies are also included as the data reported are of high comparative value Finally we also welcomed submissions of meta analytical articles mini reviews and perspective papers which offer provocative and insightful interpretations of the recent literature in the field

Brains, Genes, and the Foundations of Human Society Jordan Grafman,Chad E. Forbes, The last 20 years have yielded an explosion of information from the still nascent field of social neuroscience Studies devoted to identifying neural correlates of social cognitive and moral judgment processing have established subcortical and cortical regions that are integral for how we filter and interpret information pertinent to family and friends our social in group and strangers and engage in everything from forming immediate impressions of them to judging their behavior with respect to complex moral norms What is less clear is how neural regions involved in implicit and explicit cognitive processing or those cognitive processes that occur almost instantaneously as opposed to those that are more controlled respectively interact to bias perceptions and behavior Even less is known about how genes and their variants critical for neural function and the structural integrity within neural regions may modulate neural interactions critical for social cognitive and moral judgment processing Recent methodological advancements assessing how different neural regions functionally work together with

others and how different genetic variants integral for neural function alter behavior are establishing a more comprehensive view of the implicit and explicit social brain. These advancements demonstrate that structures critical for implicit processing e.g. the amygdala reliably covary in their activity with structures integral for explicit processing e.g. dorsolateral prefrontal cortex early and often during the processing of social information of varying complexity and in different contexts. This suggests that interactions between these regions are necessary to successfully navigate and immediately adapt to one's environment. In turn, genetic variants like those that comprise the brain derived neurotrophic factor (BDNF) gene, oxytocin receptor gene, or serotonin transporter gene likely play an important role in modulating the interaction between and within neural regions integral for interpersonal trust, intergroup processes, person perception, theory of mind i.e. inferring the thoughts and feelings of others, and moral judgment processing. The purpose of this Research Topic is to further our understanding of how subcortical and cortical neural regions that vary in their functional contributions to social behavior also depend upon genetic influences in shaping individuals' perceptions, beliefs, attitudes, behaviors, and how information is attended to and encoded to influence future social behaviors. It is particularly important to demonstrate how these regions reliably interact as a function of processing speed i.e. implicit or explicit and/or context to predict behavior or performance. Demonstrating how different genetic factors in turn moderate this interaction or how genetic factors alter a specific region's interaction with other regions is equally important. We therefore solicit original empirical work, review and opinion papers, and methodological papers that can promote our understanding of how interactions between neural regions underlying implicit and explicit processes influence social cognitive and moral judgment processing and are in turn modulated by genetic predispositions. This includes work that utilizes fMRI, EEG, and psychophysiological methodologies, lesion samples, as well as developmental and computational approaches. This Research Topic could serve as an important step in the evolution of our understanding of the complexity of the social mind, as well as illuminate the robust effects context has on the way the brain interacts with different stimuli at every level of cognitive processing.
