 Aid and study along with your course.
- . Place a check mark on the upper right-hand corner of a page completed to keep track of what you have already done.
- Meet with a study partner 2-3 times a week to quiz each other ever the First Aid pages read in previous weeks.
- Look at your med school schedule now and determine which weeks you will study less for the USMLE and which you will need to devote more time to complete the study plan.
- Each week, set aside a small amount of time to quickly review the First Aid pages that you read the previous week.
- If this plan is too difficult, then ditch the "Additional Books" and use them as reference resources when reviewing First Aid.
- If this plan is still too difficult, then bump the number of weekly questions down to 75-100g/wk.
