Batsani-Ncube, 2025-05-12 *China and African Parliaments* maps the political controversies surrounding the designing, making and utilisation of three parliament buildings in Southern Africa that were financed and constructed by the People's Republic of China. The book is the first to explore and explain the impact of China's expanding influence in African parliaments. The financing of African parliament buildings is a new and tangible phenomenon around which to understand China-Africa relations, the evolution of African parliaments and policy-relevant debates on contemporary representative politics in Africa. The first contribution is to advance a ground-breaking argument that China's method of donating Parliament buildings to African countries indicates that it is targeting the institution as a site of long-term influence.
