The Open World, Hackbacks and Global Justice A. Jean Thomas, 2023-01-13 This book explores the current impasse that global regulators face in the digital sphere. Computer technology has advanced human civilization tenfold, but the freedom to interact with others in cyberspace has made individuals, discrete communities, organizations, and governments more vulnerable to abuse. In consequence, political decision makers are seriously considering granting limited legal immunity to victims who decide to hack back.
