The conflict in Nepal 1996-2006 resulted in an estimated 15 000 deaths, 1 300 disappearances along with other serious human rights and humanitarian law violations. Demands for peace, democracy, accountability and development have abounded in the post conflict context. Although the conflict catalysed major changes in the social and political landscape in Nepal, the transitional justice (TJ) process has remained deeply contentious and fragmented. This book provides an in depth analysis of the transitional justice process in Nepal.
