**Eucharistic Presence** Robert Sokolowski, 1994 In this insightful interdisciplinary study Robert Sokolowski uses the methods of phenomenology to examine Christian religious beliefs particularly the sacrament of the Eucharist In so doing he comes to terms with many theological and cultural issues raised by modernity Although the Eucharist is the center of focus other issues in Christian faith are also examined such as the Christian understanding of God Creation the Incarnation Redemption and biblical Revelation Sokolowski employs a method that he calls the theology of disclosure which studies the structures of appearance and should be distinguished from both positive and scholastic theology.
