- unsaturated fats have at least one double bond, causing them to be liquid at room temperature; most unsaturated fats are found in plantbased oils like olive oil and avocado oil
 What are trans fatty acids?
 - unhealthy fats that can increase the risk of heart disease and other health problems
 TFAs are unsaturated fatty acids that can be produced industrially or found naturally in some foods. They are created through a process called hydrogenation, which adds hydrogen to vegetable oils to make them solid at room temperature
